## WHAT ARE T LEVELS?

Technical Levels, also known as 'T Levels', are a two-year programme that will provide you with a high-quality technical alternative that is equivalent to three A Levels. Combining classroom learning with a minimum of 315 hours (approx. 45-days) industry placement, they will set you on the path to your dream career or higher level study.

From September 2023 we will be offering T Levels in:

### BUSINESS MANAGEMENT AND FINANCE

- ↑ Business Management and Administration
- ↑ Finance

### CONSTRUCTION

- ↑ Building Services Engineering for Construction (Electrical Installation)
- ↑ Design, Surveying and Planning for Construction

### DIGITAL

- ↑ Digital Business Services
- ↑ Digital Production, Design and Development
- ↑ Digital Support Services

### EDUCATION AND EARLY YEARS

- ↑ Education and Early Years (Educating Early Years)
- ↑ Education and Early Years (Assisting Teaching)

### ENGINEERING AND MANUFACTURING

- ↑ Design and Development for Engineering and Manufacturing (Electrical and Mechanical pathways)
- ↑ Maintenance, Installation and Repair (Light and Electrical Vehicles)

### HEALTH AND HEALTHCARE SCIENCE

- ↑ Health (Assisting Adult Nursing)
- ↑ Science (Laboratory Science)

If you don't quite achieve the required grades for a T Level and would still like to pursue the qualification, there is the option to study a one-year Transition Programme, which will then allow you to move on to a T Level the following year and gain a qualification at the same time\*.

## WHAT IS JUMP START?

Our Jump Start programme is an introduction to the T Levels and T Level Transition Programmes and will run for two consecutive weeks.

Students will take part in a project based learning experience to demonstrate their creativity, teamwork and problem solving skills, as well as their resilience, timekeeping and commitment.

You will learn by completing a project which contains several challenges and problems that you will need to work through and resolve. You will be asked to present to the teachers and employer sponsors at the end of the programme. You may then be asked to attend a short interview with the employer sponsors, to secure your place on the T Level or Transition Programme.

**Attendance of the Jump Start programme is part of the application process, and successful completion is part of the entry requirements for the Level 3 T Levels and Level 2 Transition Programmes.**

## WHY SHOULD I ATTEND?

Attendance and successful completion is part of the entry requirements for T Levels and Transition Programmes. Our Jump Start to T Levels programme gives you the opportunity to:

- ↑ **Get a taster of the course content**

- ↑ **Demonstrate your talent and potential if you are concerned about your grades and meeting the entry requirements for the T Levels or Transition Programmes.**
