







WHAT IS SUMMER SCHOOL?

Our Digital Summer School is a three-week online introduction to our Industry Excellence Academy T Levels and T Level Transition Programmes.

Students will take part in a project based learning experience to demonstrate their creativity, teamwork and problem solving skills, as well as their resilience, timekeeping and commitment.

The programme is designed to inspire students to think like computing professionals, digital specialists and system analysts through a range of project-based learning challenges.

Attendance at the Summer School is part of the application process and successful completion of this programme is an entry requirement for the Level 3 T Levels and Level 2 Transition Programmes in:

At the end of the Summer School, students must produce a digital product with design documentation and present this back to their teachers and employers sponsoring the T Levels and Transition Programmes.
